4.	All Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) of Tawang, West Kameng, East Kameng, Papum Pare, Lower Subansiri, Changlang and Tirap Districts of Arunachal Pradesh identified as Minority Concentrated Districts.	Member.
5.	Deputy Director (ICDS)/Child Development Project Officer or any other Officer designated as Welfare Officer.	Member
6.	District Level Officer of the department implementing the programme.	Member
7.	Zilla Parishad Member of the concerned area.	Member
8.	One member from each notified Minority Communities.	Member

The District Level Committee follows the guidelines formulated by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India for preparation of Multi-sectoral Development Plans for Minority Concentration Districts.

The District Planning Committee (DPC), wherever constituted, will consolidate the proposals made by the line departments/agencies through the District Level Committee. This Committee shall report progress of the implementation to the department dealing with Minorities of the State Government administration for placing it before the State Level Committee.

The Deputy Commissioner concerned shall make a presentation of their plan to the State Level Committee. He or She shall assist in facilitating the preparation and implementation of the district plan and ensure effective monitoring, and also shall hold quarterly meeting to review the progress of implementation of the projects under MsDP and send the reports to the State Level Committee, department dealing with minority welfare and the Ministry of Minority Affairs by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the next quarter.

This notification supersedes earlier notification of even no. dated 2<sup>nd</sup> March, 2010 issued in this effect.


